## EPLANNER & MDM CLARIFICATION: APP4 STUDENTS

### NEW STUDENTS - DOWNLOADING THE APP4 STUDENTS

Students are not expected to bring all of their school books on the first day. They should bring their iPad and have downloaded App4 Students (ePlanner) from the App Store.

Passwords to enable use of the ePlanner will be issued during the student's first day.

### STUDENTS CAN INSTALL APP4 STUDENTS:

Students create their own Apple ID *without having to put in payment details using the following instructions:*

Select App4 Students as the FREE App you'd like to download.

**When prompted to enter a date of birth, we recommend that you use a fictional date such as 01/01/2000. This protects the student's online privacy as well as by-passes Apple's 13 years or older requirement for account holders.**

There are lists of Essential and Recommended Apps which have been identified as potentially useful for students. It is up to you to decide whether you want to download and experiment with any of these Apps or wait until your teacher asks you to do so with a specific purpose in mind.

### WHAT DOES OUR MDM DO?

When installed by us on the students' first day, the MDM will:

- Create the student's school-based email account
- Enable network printing
- Check for the 12 essential Apps identified by the College and install them, if not already there.

*Note: The MDM does not remove existing Apps whether installed using the students iTunes Account or any other.*
