For over 20 years our international student program has been welcoming students from a diverse range of cultures – it is a valuable part of our school's multicultural community.

Our international students receive support from a highly experienced team of school staff. This includes year level, careers and wellbeing counsellors.

Our dedicated international student coordinator regularly reviews students' academic progression and wellbeing to ensure our students attain the goals they aspire to achieve.

We have a range of roles, services and spaces specifically for international students, including:

- our on-site English language centre
- an after school study program
- excursions and day trips to unique and interesting sites around Victoria
- bilingual support staff offering translation services for families
- regular communication with offshore families.

An academic program encouraging students to excel

Students at Werribee Secondary College partake in a range of core, elective and co-curricular programs throughout years 7 to 12. This enables them to be on track for their future pathways.

Select entry learning program (SELP)

The SELP is a selective entry program. This addresses the special learning needs of accelerated students who demonstrate a high level of commitment to academic achievement.

SELP offers a combination of a specially designed curriculum, well-practiced teaching expertise and a developed culture of high expectations. Therefore, students are stimulated, challenged and motivated towards even higher levels of achievement.

Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE)

Our College offers a wide selection of studies within the VCE. This program suits those looking to undertake university studies and employment within Australia.

Vocational Education and Training (VET)

Students can gain valuable, practical skills in a specific industry while undertaking their VCE. Some units run in house with others taking place across a cluster of local schools.

Making welfare and support a priority

At Werribee Secondary College, we do our best to ensure international students receive the support they need at all stages of their education.

We know that school and life can provide challenges – we take a holistic approach to the pastoral care of all our international students.

We have a wide range of teams and programs that we offer to accommodate students' individual needs including:

student wellbeing services:

- addressing both educational support as well as therapeutic needs
- professional staff providing counselling services; with qualifications and expertise specific to the area of wellbeing

student management:

- year level coordinators assisting students in managing their day-to-day activity at school.
- coordinators and support staff who are always on hand to answer questions, assist with any problems/ issues arising or point a student in the right direction

personal careers counselling:

 these staff individually provide support for international students with school subject choices and university placement requirements

an after-school study program:

 this is supervised by specialist teachers who provide additional academic and wellbeing support to international students

our international student coordinator:

 provides highly experienced support available at any time to students and their families. This is regarding any aspect of their enrolment and wellbeing.

Homestay for international students

All Victorian government school homestay families provide:

- a safe, secure, welcoming place to live
- a household compliant with the Child Safe Standards
- a separate single room for the student's personal use
- three meals a day, seven days a week, including snacks
- facilities including a bed, wardrobe, towels and linen
- utilities including gas, electricity, heating and water costs, as well as internet
- cleaning services of common living areas
- the use of living areas within the residence
- study facilities such as a desk, study light and bookcase
- attendance at parent/teacher evenings on behalf of your parents.
